

- Carries 40,000 items
- Nation's largest retailer of arts and crafts materials






Population by Town








- The mean population for towns containing A.C. Moore stores is 1602.

A.C. Moore and Michaels Arts and Crafts Stores in Massachusetts based on Medium Household Income




Medium Household Income

Results

- Population by town
 - The difference between the mean population for each store is about 400.
- Medium household income
 - The difference between the mean household income is \$1,895.
- Location
 - Highest distance: 56476 meters (35 miles)
 - Lowest distance: 800 meters (.5 miles)
 - Average: 16640.7 meters (10.3 miles)
