 - US Census Tracts
- Other Necessary Data
 - Listing of Districts in Boston
 - Crime Statistics for December, 2005

Methodology

- Steps taken to make my map
 - Research crime in Boston
 - Find layers
 - · Towns in MA
 - · Census Tracts
 - Draw Districts
 - Select features, create layers for each, export to save
 - Dissolve for each District Layer
- · ... Continued on Next Slide

Methodology Continued

- · Add Field to each District layer
 - Name the field according to the area
 - Add in the crime total for December, 2005
- Use the Union function to create one map that includes all the separate district layers
 - "Boston" map
- · On the "Boston" map, create graduated color
